

## CESAREAN RATE IN INDIA

The C-section rate in India has risen to approximately 21.5% (2019–2021, NFHS-5 by MOHFW), increasing from 17.2% in 2015-16.

This rate exceeds the WHO-recommended 10-15% range, driven primarily by private healthcare, where C-section rates are much higher (17.4%) compared to public institutions (14.3%).

Goal of standardizing the technique of the routine, cesarean delivery (CD) is to decrease morbidity while optimizing neonatal outcomes.

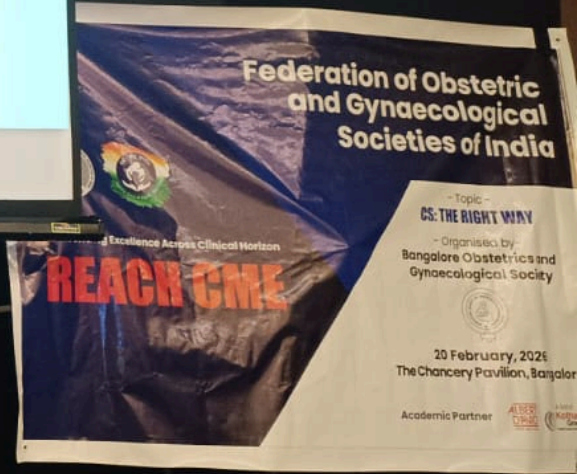

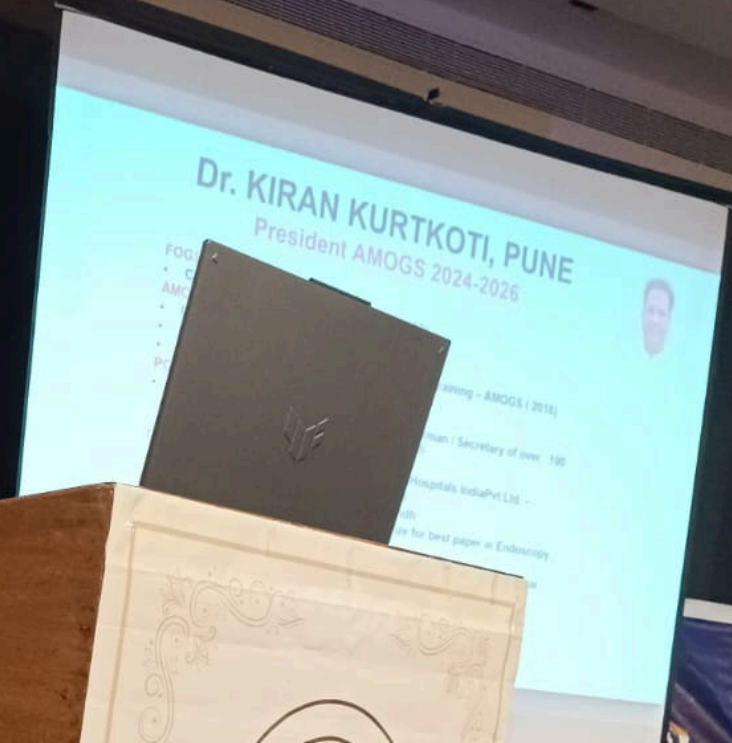
